Subject: Department of Health Care Finance Timely Access Standards for

Non-physician Services

HSCSN sets standards for timely access to services and we hold providers accountable to those standards. The purpose of this notification is to remind you of HSCSN's expectation and timeline for provider compliance.

Services authorized for all non-physician services <u>must</u> be initiated within 30 days. If services are not initiated by the 30<sup>th</sup> day of receipt of an authorization, notification must be made to the Utilization Management Department. This is an HSCSN standard based on the expectations set forth by the Department of Health Care Finance. This standard excludes Private Duty Nursing and Personal Care Aide Services.

HSCSN's Provider Relations Department monitors access and availability within our network. The Provider Relations Department ensures that access standards are observed by contracted providers and potential deficiencies are addressed within our provider network. This is a reminder that sanctions may apply to providers who are out of compliance with any HSCSN standard for timely access to care and services.
