Re: Enrollment in DC Medicaid Program Required by April 30, 2020

Dear Provider:

Federal Law requires all Medicaid Managed Care Behavior Health Network Providers to enroll with the DC State Medicaid program by January 1, 2020. Health Services for Children with Special Needs, Inc. (HSCSN) has identified that you are not currently enrolled in the DC Medicaid program. In order to continue participating in the HSCSN Network, you must enroll in the DC Medicaid program by <u>April 30, 2020</u>.

How to Enroll in the DC Medicaid Program

To enroll, you will need to complete the electronic DC Medicaid application using the DC Department of Health Care Finance's (DHCF) Provider Data Management System (PDMS). You can access PDMS at https://www.dcpdms.com/Account/Login.aspx. At this website, you will also find an enrollment guide entitled *How to Enroll for the Provider Data Management System (PDMS) Web Portal User Manual.* You can download that guide for technical assistance. Once you have logged into the PDMS website, please select the "MCO Only" application type, and then begin enrollment. Your application must be completed in PDMS by April 30, 2020.

You may receive this notice from multiple Medicaid Managed Care plans; however, you only need to submit one (1) DC Medicaid enrollment application. Please note that enrollment as a DC Medicaid provider does not obligate you to accept Medicaid fee-forservice patients.
